EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1-1990

REDUCTION OF WORKING HOURS

The continuing deterioration of the American Samoa Government (ASG) Financial Status has compelled me to reduce the work week from 40 to 36 hours for ASG employees. Effective January 15, 1990, employees will be required to work 8 hours from Monday through Thursday, and from 7:30 a.m. to Noon on Friday for a total of 36 hours per week.

Exemption to this rule are employees on two year contracts with ASG - doctors, nurses, and other medical staff required to man shifts on a 24 hour basis, police officers and ASPA employees providing power generation for the Territory. All other ASG employees not covered in the above categories will be required to work 36 hours a week.

You are directed to plan your employees' work schedule to insure your department's services to the public are not greatly affected.

This policy will remain in effect until the financial condition of the ASG improves.
