TRANSFER OF CERTAIN HUMAN RESOURCES PROGRAMS

TO THE OFFICE OF MANPOWER RESOURCES

There is a long standing need to improve the development and management of the extensive human resource potential of American Samoa. This need has been clearly recognized in the final recommendations of July 26, 1985 by the Temporary Executive Branch Reorganization Commission established on February 12, 1985 to place many of the labor and community service programs of the American Samoa Government in a single agency. Therefore, by the authority vested in the Governor of American Samoa by the Revised Constitution and laws of American Samoa, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1. Transfer of programs to the Office of Manpower Resources.

The following programs are transferred to the Office of Manpower Resources:

1. foster care, child protection, adoption services, youth and health promotions programs and drug and alcohol abuse programs from the Department of Health;
2. youth shelter programs from the Department of Parks & Recreation; and
3. criminal and juvenile justice programs from the Department of Public Safety.

Section 2. Retention of programs in the Office.

The following programs will remain in the Office of Manpower Resources:

1. vocational rehabilitation programs;
2. developmental disabilities programs;
3. client assistance and protection and advocacy programs; and
4. labor market information programs.

Section 3. Transition plan and implementation.

The Director of Manpower Resources shall establish the schedule for and oversee the orderly transfer of programs, agencies, personnel, unobligated funds, and property necessary to implement this Executive Order. The Directors of Health, Parks and Recreation, and Program Planning and Budget, Commissioner of Public Safety and the Treasurer shall fully cooperate and assist in this implementation.

Section 4. Supercession.

This Executive Order supercedes all prior executive orders and general memoranda pertaining to the organization of the Government labor and community service programs enumerated in this Executive order.

Section 5. Effective date.

This Executive Order is effective immediately.
