EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 7-1987

PETROLEUM STORAGE FACILITIES
TERMINAL FEE

By the authority vested in the Governor of American American Samoa by the Revised Constitution and laws of American Samoa, it is hereby ordered as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Article 6 of the Permit and Agrement of July 1, 1984, as amended, effective July 15, 1984, PRI South Pacific, Inc. ("PRISP"), as the terminal operator, shall charge and collect a temporary terminal fee of one cent (\$0.01) on each gallon of petroleum products put through the American Samoa Government's ("ASG") tank farm facilities.
- 2. PRISP shall collect the terminal fee from all its purchasers and other suppliers of petroleum products and pay it over to the ASG on or before thirty (30) days after the close of each calendar quarter.
- 3. The terminal fee shall be stated on all invoices and bills of sale as a separate line item or charge.
- 4. The terminal fees collected shall be used by the ASG for capital improvements to the tank farm, including the construction of new storage tanks.
  - 5. This Executive Order is effective immediately.
