Coleman Governor Primer to Sove

## EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 011 -1990

WHEREAS, on January 13, 1989, the Governor issued General Memorandum No. 10-1989 to establish a Task Force on Government Non-Expendable properties; and

WHEREAS, this Task Force was directed by the Governor to investigate an audit report from the U.S. Inspector General's Office of American Samoa Government properties for the previous 4 years; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force followed through with its mandate by completing a Government-wide physical inventory of all non-expended property, requiring all departments or agencies of the Government to designate a property management officer to be responsible for maintaining current property records and controlling and safeguarding all non-expendable property and conducting seminars or training for said officers to learn their duties and responsibilities, and ensuring that each department and agency conducts an annual inventory of its non-expendable property and that the results are reconciled with the official records of the Procurement Office; and

WHEREAS, a reconciliation of the Government wide inventory was also completed; and

WHEREAS, a legislative investigating committee further reviewed the results of the Government inventory; and

WHEREAS, a figure of over \$2,000,000 was finally arrived at as the verified amount of all missing and unaccounted for non-expendable property.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of American Samoa under the provisions of Article IV of the Revised Constitution of American Samoa, and Section 14.0303 of the American Samoa Code Annotated, I, PETER TALI COLEMAN, Governor of American Samoa, do hereby order and decree as follows:

1. That a Property Management Board is hereby vested with the authority to execute and enforce the mandate of this Executve Order.

This Executive Order shall become effective immediately.
