AN ACT APPROPRIATING \$300,000 FROM INCOME EARNED BY THE AMERICAN SAMOA COMMUNITY COLLEGE LAND GRANT ENDOWMENT FUND TO PROVIDE MATCHING FUNDS FOR FEDERAL EXTENSION SERVICES FUND FOR LAND GRANT ACTIVITIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 1991 AND TO IMPROVE HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SERVICE PROGRAMS IN THE COLLEGE.

PREAMBLE:

Due to the emergency need to provide matching funds for federal extension services grant to improve college programs, this bill is effective upon passage by the Legislature and approval by the Governor.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from income earned by the American Samoa Community College land grant endowment fund the amount of \$300,000 to the American Samoa Community College. The Community College shall use the funds solely to provide matching funds for federal extension services awarded the American Samoa Community College land grant program and to improve humanities and social service programs in the college as follows:

- (a) \$200,000 to match federal extension service fund for Land Grant activities for fiscal year 1991; and

(b) \$100,000 to improve humanities and social service programs in the college.

This appropriation carries over to succeeding fiscal years until the completion of the federal extension services grant program for fiscal year 1991 for which matching funds provided by this act are utilized.

Any funds remaining unexpended at the completion of the programs specified above, must revert to the American Samoa Community College land grant endowment fund and may not be expended until subsequent appropriation by the Legislature.

Sec 2. Effective date.

This act is effective upon passage by the Legislature and approval by the Governor.



Ona o se mana'oga fa'anatinati e sauni se tupe fa'afetaui mo se foa'i tupe o tautua fa'aopoopo a le malo tele e fa'alelei ai polokalama a le kolisi, o lenei pili o le a taualoa vave pe a pasia e le Fono Faitulafono ma fa'amaonia e le Kovana.

IA FA'ATULAFONOINA E LE FONO FAITULAFONO O AMERIKA SAMOA:

Maga 1. Ua fa'asoaina mai tupe sa maua mai le teugatupe o tupe maua o eleele foa'i a le Kolisi Tu'ufa'atasi a Amerika Samoa le aofa'iga e \$300,000 i le Kolisi Tu'ufaatasi a Amerika Samoa. Ia fa'aaoga lenei tupe e le Kolisi Tu'ufa'atasi a Amerika Samoa mo le fa'amoemoe e saunia ai se tupe fa'afetaui mo tautua fa'aopoopo a le malo tele e tu'uina atu i le polokalama o eleele foa'i o le Kolisi Tu'ufaatasi a Amerika Samoa ma fa'aleleia polokalama a tagata ma tautua lautele i le kolisi ua taua i lalo:

- (a) \$200,000 e saunia ai tupe o tautua fa'aopoopo a le malo tele mo gaoioiga o Eleele Foa'i mo le tausaga tupe 1991; ma

(e) \$100,000 e fa'alelei ai polokalama mo tagata ma tautua lautele i le kolisi.
