

THE TWENTY-SECOND LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA

First Regular Session

Begun and held at Fagatogo, Tutuila, American Samoa
on Monday, the fourteenth day of January
one thousand nine hundred and ninety one

AN ACT APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$12,000 FROM UNBUDGETED AND UNOBLIGATED FUNDS OF FISCAL YEAR 1991 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING TWO BUS SHELTERS IN THE VILLAGE OF LELOALOA.

PREAMBLE:

This act is effective immediately upon passage by the Legislature and approval by the Governor due to the urgent need to construct the bus shelters.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA:

Section 1. Appropriation of funds.

There is appropriated from unbudgeted and unobligated funds of Fiscal Year 1991 the sum of \$12,000 to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of constructing two bus shelters in the village of Leloaloe.


Any funds remaining unexpended and unobligated at the end of Fiscal Year 1991 shall carry over to Fiscal Year 1992 and until:

- (a) the completion of the project; or
- (b) three calendar years from the effective date of this act, whichever occurs first.


Any funds remaining unexpended and unobligated at the end of the period authorized by this act revert to the general fund and may not be expended or obligated without subsequent appropriation by the Legislature.

Sec 2. Effective date.

This act is effective upon passage and approval by the Governor to fulfill budgetary requirement for Fiscal Year 1991.




