First Regular Session

Begun and held at Fagatogo, Tutuila, American Samoa on Monday, the fourteenth day of January one thousand nine hundred and ninety one

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CREDIT CARD USE IN AMERICAN SAMOA; CREATING A NEW SECTION 28.1505 ASCA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA:

Section 1. There is created a new section 28.1505 which reads:

"28.1505 Credit Cards.

(a) Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary, the maximum rate of interest chargeable on an extension of credit arising from the use of a credit card issued to a resident of American Samoa shall be determined by reference to the law of the issuer's principal place of business.

(b) For the purpose of this section, "credit card" means any card, plate, coupon book, or other single credit device, issued with or without fee by an issuer for the use of the cardholder in obtaining money, goods, services, or anything else of value from time to time, on credit.

(c) This section shall not apply to extensions of credit under an overdraft line of credit agreement accessible through the use of a credit card."
