

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO.6-1980

DISUSE OF AIR CONDITIONERS  
IN PUBLIC FACILITIES

Effective immediately, and until further notice, there is to be no use of air conditioners in any facilities of the executive branch of the Government, except in areas without ventilation or for essential protection of equipment. This action is necessary in order to cope effectively with the present critical situation in electrical power production and assist in meeting private and public needs for electricity as fully and fairly as practicable until adequate capacity is restored.

All exceptions must be requested of the Governor's Office and have the Lieutenant Governor's express approval.

This order is to be disseminated immediately throughout the executive branch to all personnel. Inspections will be made periodically, and any executive branch official or employee who fails to comply with this order is subject to appropriate disciplinary action. However, the understanding and cooperation of, and voluntary compliance with this order by, all officials and employees is essential and expected to serve the intended purpose well.
