**AN ACT INCREASING THE OFFICE EXPENSE FUND FOR THE
MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE; AMENDING SECTION 2.0104
A.S.C.A.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA:

Section 1. 2.0104 is amended to read:

"2.0104 Office expense fund for Legislators.

~~Beginning with the Twentieth Legislature, there shall be paid to each member of the Legislature in equal biweekly installments an expense allowance of \$5,000 per annum; and for the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives an expense allowance of \$10,000 per annum. This allowance is for the purpose of defraying expenses relating to or resulting from the discharge of their official duties. No accounting of the expense other than for income tax purposes is required.~~

(a) There shall be paid in equal biweekly installments an annual expense allowance of:

(1) \$15,000 per annum to each member of the Senate and House of Representatives; and

(2) \$20,000 per annum to the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives.

(b) This allowance is for the purpose of defraying expenses relating to or resulting from the discharge of their official duties. An accounting of the expenditures incurred by the member is not required.


The allowance provided in this section is not income and the member
is not required to report the amount of the allowance as income for tax
purposes.

Sec 2. Revenue source.

For FY 2001, this measure shall be funded by adjustments made
within the personnel cost line item of the budget for the Legislature.
Thereafter, it shall be funded as part of the regular fiscal year budget for the
Legislature."






